

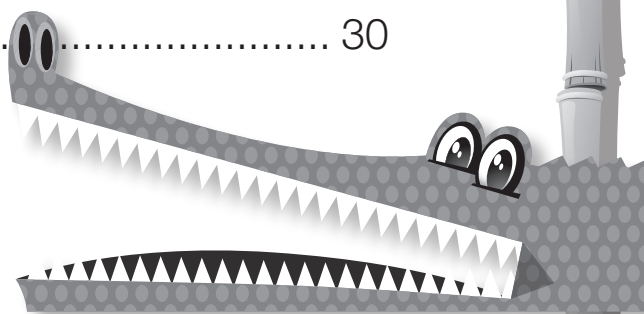

This is what a pair of eighth notes look like:



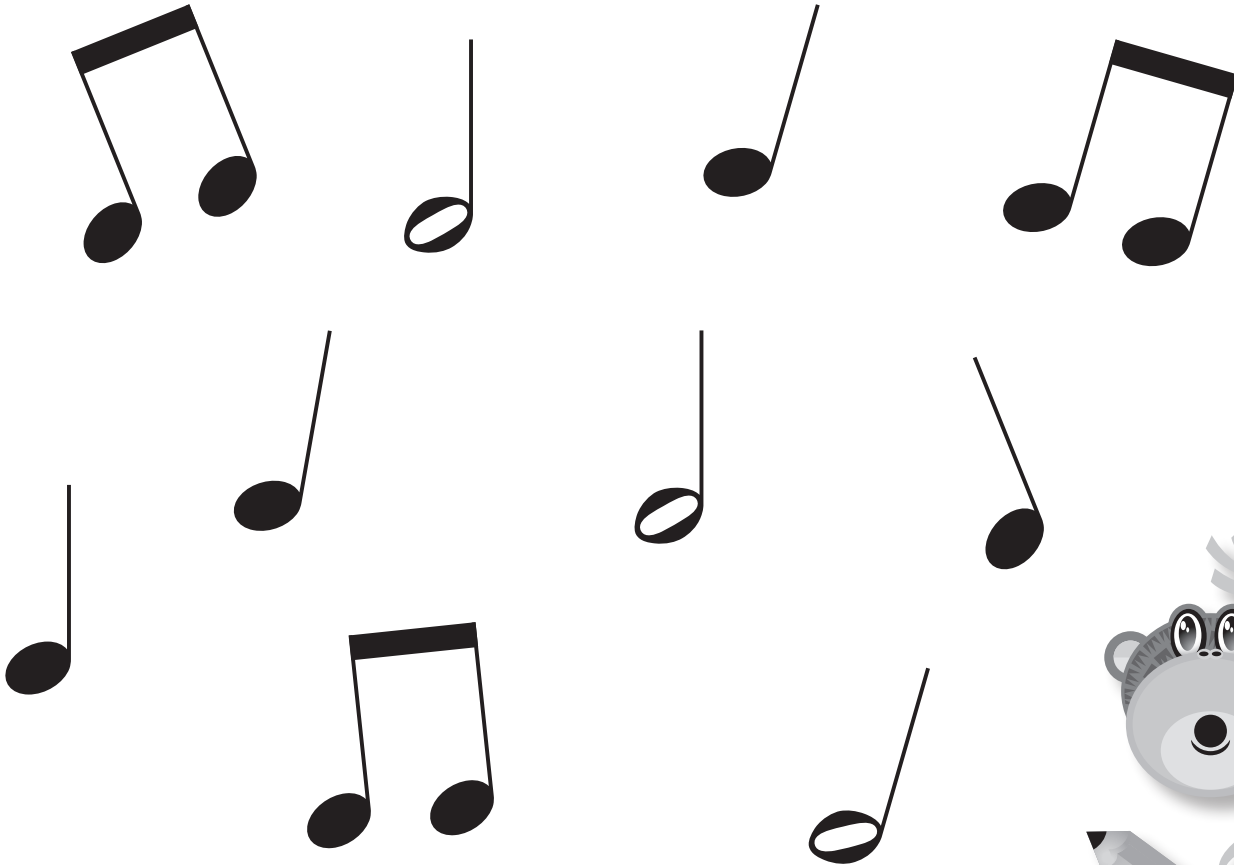

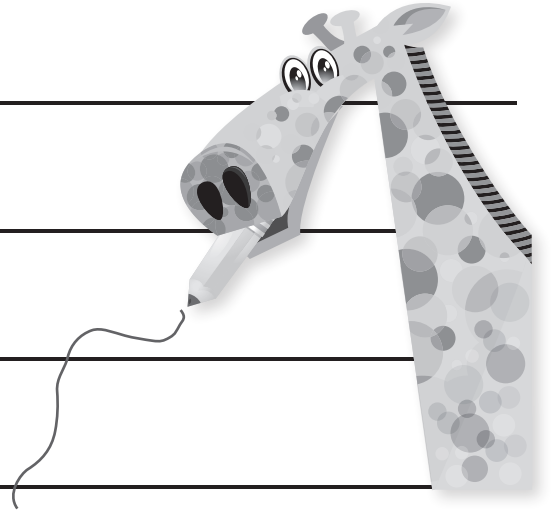
