COUNTRY MUSIC

Often played on fiddle and pedal steel

Uses spoken instead of sung words

CLASSICAL MUSIC

Heard on Top-40 radio

Played by symphony orchestras

POP MUSIC

Associated with ragtime rhythms

Often has music videos

JAZZ

Players often improvise

Plays notes exactly as written

MUSICAL THEATRE

Composed from 1600 – 1800

Performed with singing, dancing, and dialogue

THE BLUES

Simple and sad lyrics

Played by symphonies

RAP AND HIP-HOP

Uses “samples” from other songs

Rooted in Appalachian music

RAGTIME

Found in operas

Popular in the U.S. from 1895-1915
