Early on the first morning after Sabbath, two of Jesus' friends, Mary Magdalene and Mary, the mother of James, started out to the grave with spices and perfumes with which they would anoint the body. *(begin music)* As they approached the tomb, they saw something that would change their lives and the lives of millions of people for generations.
