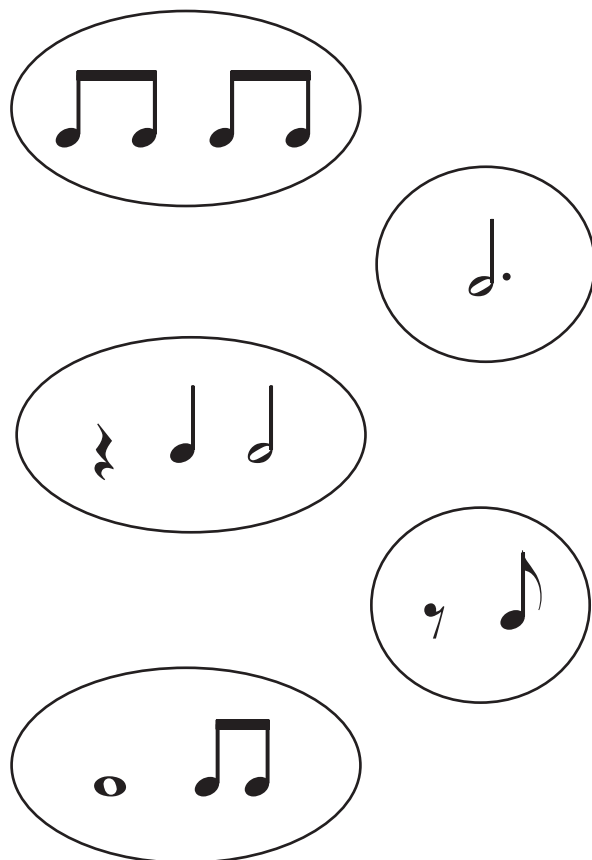


Super Rhythm

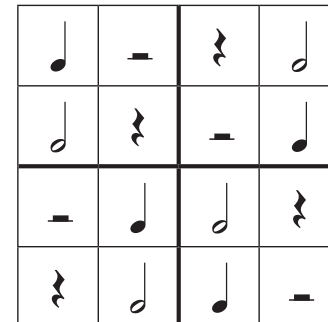

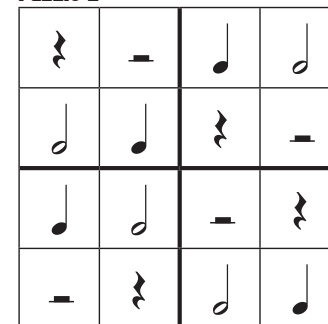

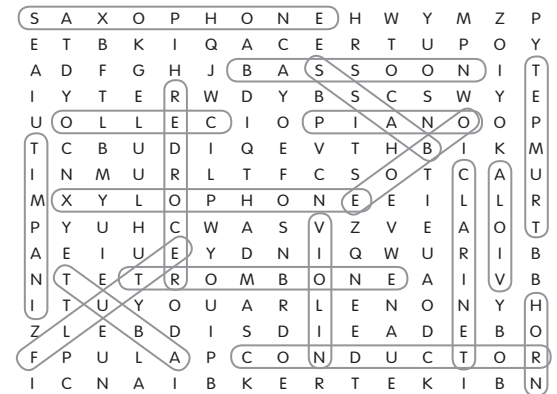
