(Look through your hand tunnel)

It's under the channel between England and France.
(Show children on a map or point with fingers in the air)

Have you ever been there? Have you had the chance?
(Lift shoulders)

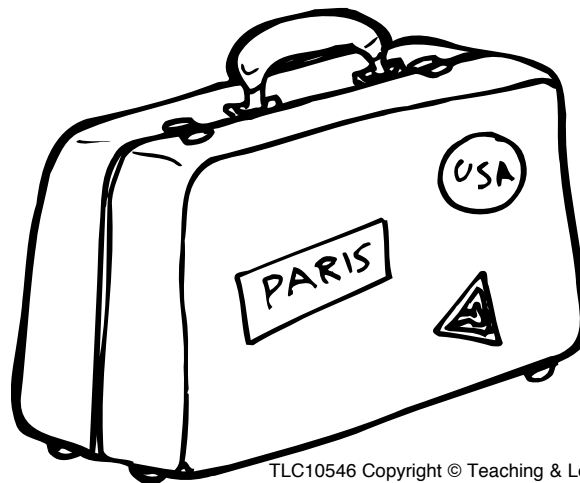
Let's go there, just you and me.
(Point to children then yourself)

Let's go there. What will we see?
(Place hands above eyes)

Let's hop into our car and drive in through;
(Hop)

Buckle the seat belts and turn on the lights too.
(Pretend to buckle seat belts)

Hold on to the wheel and be sure to drive straight;



("Drive" across room)

Keep the wheel steady and concentrate.
(Hold onto a "wheel")

There are bright lights all around
(Stretch arms up)

To guide us through underground.
(Make tunnel shape with hands)

Can you hear water dripping like rain?
(Place hands over ears and wiggle fingers)

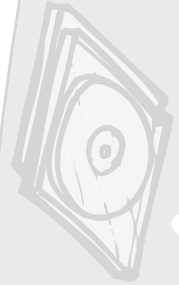
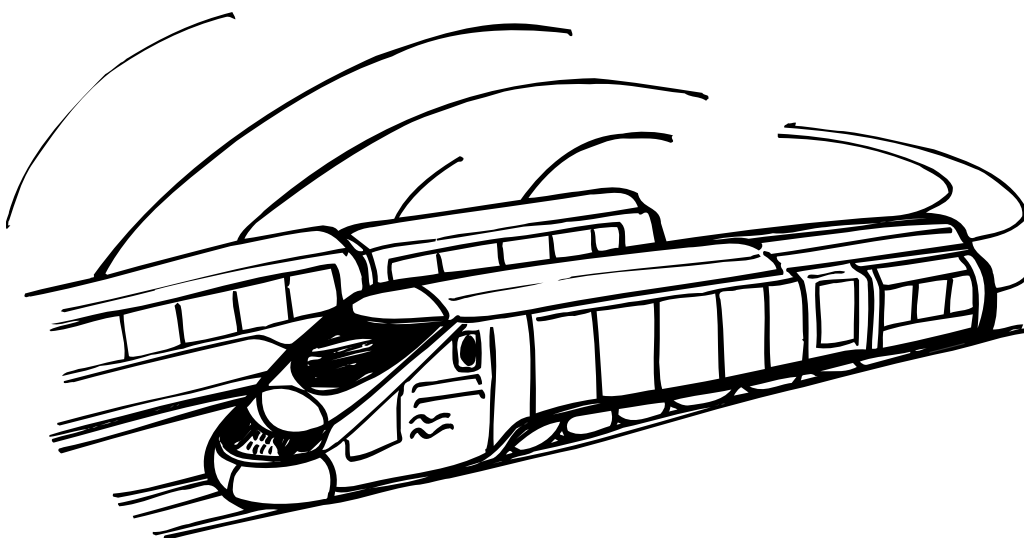
I think the tunnel is leaking again!
